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How to Apply for the MRS Certificate

Upon advisement

1. The student must pay the CAP application fee (\$7.00) for the award of the certificate [online via the Student Center](#).
2. The student prepares a Certificate Approved Program ([CAP Form](#)) and submits the form and unofficial transcript(s) as evidence to the certificate advisor (and/or chair) for an approval signature.
3. The chair confirms all requirements for the certificate have been completed by signing the CAP form and submits the CAP form to [Khaled Ezzat](#) in Graduate Studies.

Processing Notes

- CAP forms submitted through DocuSign are preferred.
- Students can attach a receipt of payment to the DocuSign envelope.
- Forms routed outside of DocuSign must be submitted by the **academic department directly** to Khaled Ezzat (khaled@sfsu.edu) via email.
